

Meeting Minutes

Old business:

Howland and Robinson intersection

SF reported that the bushes have been cleared. MD noted another complaint has been received. Committee decided to close the matter.

No parking sign on South Street

MM moved the sign back to prevent cars from blocking driveway

2-hour parking signs on Eliza Street

MD suggested buying some signs and not waiting for the developer to do so. MD will ask MM to do this. MM will discuss with Dave Buckely.

Bank Street – no parking here to corner

MM completed this task.

West Church Street/traffic West End of Mani St development and parking

Data from traffic monitor doesn't show there is a problem. Committee decided to close the matter.

Verplank and Matteawan – dangerous intersection for pedestrians

MM completed this task.

Intersection of Anderson and Grove

Stop sign was put up.

New business:

Prospect and Alice

Issue: Parking signage is confusing; no parking between signs sign may be missing a sign.

Committee Recommendation: MM to put up missing sign on north side of intersection

Dutchess Terrace, Barrett Place

Issue: Harley Fine wrote a letter detailing how motorists do not stop for stop signs in the neighborhood

Committee Recommendation: SF will send emails to the evening shift to have PD have a greater presence in the evening hours at the location.

Spring Valley

Issue: Parking problem on Spring Valley extending from Churchill Street during Can Releases at Hudson Valley Brewery.

Committee Recommendations: SF PD will monitor. MD will ask Dave Buckley to find out who owns the strip of property adjacent to the wooded area across from houses where people are parking.

Goodrich and Union

No issue was identified at this location. CM will ask the City Administrator what the issue is.

Union and Prospect/Green Street Park


