Mayor Kyriacou has outlined the agenda for two community forums to solicit input on building and development in Beacon. The forums are designed to be educational, and to encourage participation from residents. All are welcome to attend. Each forum will have two components:

- (1) An educational segment, where residents can hear about the city's Comprehensive Plan, development activity, and recent zoning changes to better manage development; and
- (2) A community input segment, where residents can have an opportunity to discuss these issues, using the help of an outside facilitator with planning and zoning expertise.
