LIFEGUARDS FOR THE 2022 SUMMER SEASON

DESCRIPTION:

The City of Beacon is looking for Lifeguards to work the 2022 summer season in the Recreation Department. This is important work involving the responsibility for the life and protection of persons swimming or otherwise using the recreational facilities of our pool. Lifeguards may be required to rescue persons experiencing difficulties in the water and administer life-saving techniques. Lifeguards may also be required to administer simple first aid when necessary.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must meet requirements of Part 6 of the New York State Sanitary Code: Candidates must possess acceptable aquatic/lifeguard certification recognized by the New York State Department of Health and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certification. All CPR certificates are valid for 1 year from course completion, regardless of the expiration date noted on the card.

SALARY/HOURS:

\$15.00-\$18.00 per hour, working 15-40 hours per week upon availability, Sunday through Saturday.

LENGTH OF SERVICE:

June 26, 2022 through Labor Day 2022
