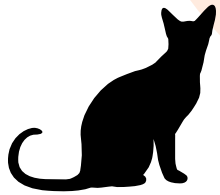


HOCUS POCUS HALLOWEEND SCHEDULE

Friday (10/28):

- 3:30-6:30: trick-or-treating along Beacon's Main St.!

 - A pin with a number for the children to wear throughout the weekend if they would like to participate in the costume contest. Business owners will use these numbers to judge the costume contest.
