**RESOLUTION NO. 47 OF 2022**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF BEACON VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS WHO QUALIFY FOR LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD CREDIT FOR 2021**

**WHEREAS**, Article 11-A of the General Municipal Law was enacted to aid in the recruitment and retention of volunteer firefighters by permitting the establishment of a Length of Service Award Program (“LOSAP”), which the Beacon City Council has previously authorized; and

**WHEREAS**, based on LOSAP requirements, the City of Beacon Fire Chief has posted for thirty days at the Beacon Fire Department Stations the attached certified list of active volunteer firefighters who qualify for LOSAP contribution for the year 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, following the public posting, the Fire Chief has presented the attached certified list of active volunteer firefighters to the Mayor and City Council.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council have reviewed the list of volunteer firefighters who qualify for LOSAP credit for the year 2021 and hereby approve the award of credit as detailed in the attached certified list.
