**RESOLUTION NO. 127 OF 2022**

**ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. 10 OF 2022 WHICH AMENDS CHAPTER 223 OF THE  
CITY CODE REGARDING OFF-STREET PARKING**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-112, passed on August 15, 2022, the City of Beacon City Council set a public hearing for September 19, 2022 regarding the proposed City of Beacon Local Law No. 10 of 2022 (“proposed Local Law”) which amends Chapter 223 of the City Code regarding off-street parking (“Public Hearing”); and

**WHEREAS**, notice for the Public Hearing was published in the Poughkeepsie Journal on August 19, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Hearing was held on September 19, 2022 and the City of Beacon City Council provided the opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed Local Law; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 19, 2022, the City of Beacon City Council tabled the Public Hearing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council in accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”) and upon review of the Short Environmental Assessment Form and all other materials prepared, hereby adopts the attached Negative Declaration for the proposed Local Law finding that the adoption of the proposed Local Law will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Beacon City Council hereby adopts Proposed Local Law No. 10 of 2022 which amends Chapter 223 of the City Code regarding off-street parking.
