**RESOLUTION NO. 4 OF 2023**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROVE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES**

**WHEREAS**, on November 21, 2022, the City of Beacon City Council, after a due public hearing and full consideration, authorized the adoption of the 2023 City Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Beacon has an administrative form of government whereby the City Administrator implements policies and decisions made by the Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Administrator is authorized to enter into contracts and agreements for expenditures authorized within the adopted 2023 City Budget as specified therein specifically and in general for funds allocated within budget lines for i) general commodities/services (commonly referred to as a Purchase Contract in accordance with NYS General Municipal Law (“GML”) Section 103, for amounts under \$20,000.00; ii) for contracts for services, labor and construction Public Works for amounts under \$35,000.00; and iii) for any expenditure under \$20,000 not falling within either category, so long as such purchase is consistent with the appropriations set forth in the approved budget and quotes obtained in a manner consistent with the City of Beacon’s procurement policy.
