**The City of Beacon Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of full time Police Officer.**

The City of Beacon Police Department is a full-time, New York State accredited police department located approximately 55 miles from New York City, along the Hudson River. The department serves a diverse, up and coming community of approximately 14,000 residents and is staffed by 36 full-time police officers. The department is a full-service agency with both Patrol and Detective Divisions and significant opportunities for training and advancement.

Applicants must currently serve as full-time police officers in a police department in the State of New York. **This now includes the NYPD.** Hiring will be under the conditions of resignation reinstatement. Applicants must have been hired off of an open competitive civil service examination, successfully completed their probationary period and have a valid certificate showing full and successful completion of the MPTC Basic Course for Police Officers. They also must reside within 30 miles (as measured in a straight line) from the City of Beacon upon employment. Applicants meeting the above requirements will start at **\$74,939** per year for 2026.

Please note that, current part-time police officers and certified police officers who were *not* hired from a competitive civil service list cannot be considered unless they meet the above qualifications or are currently reachable on the Dutchess County civil service list for Police Officer/Deputy Sheriff. Candidates will also need to successfully pass a background check which includes a polygraph exam and psychological exam.
