RESIDENT NOTIFICATION TRAINING EXERCISE

The City of Beacon Fire Department will be conducting a planned fire department training exercise on Mountain Lane and surrounding streets.

What is Happening?

The Fire Department will be conducting a water shuttle and tanker operations drill simulating a residential structure fire on Mountain Lane. The objective of this exercise is to practice utilizing mutual aid resources to transport and supply large amounts of water to a simulated house fire in an area with limited hydrant access.

Why is this Drill Important?

This training helps ensure the Fire Department and mutual aid partners are prepared to respond effectively to emergencies with the proper staffing, equipment, and operational strategy needed to protect life and property.

What Residents Should Expect

- Mountain Lane may experience temporary traffic delays or restricted access for up to approximately 90 minutes during the exercise.
- Numerous emergency vehicles and firefighters will be operating in the area.
- Due to the planned use of several fire hydrants, residents may temporarily experience discolored water. This condition is generally temporary and should clear by running cold water for several minutes if experienced.
